India Association of San Antonio was formed in 1978 and acquired its non-profit status in 1980.

In the last forty two years, the population of the Indian community has grown from about sixty families to well over four thousand families or more. During this period, many sister organizations were created, catering to the specific needs of the various subsets of the Indian community. The objective of IASA is to support cultural, educational, religious and charitable activities, for the benefit of its members and the general public.

Listed below are our achievements:

- In 2020, we raised over 6000K for the COVID needs for Masks which was a great disaster and lot of volunteers helped us with making masks and we helped distribute to various organizations
- Raised money for a home for 'Habitat for Humanity,' and the home was built exclusively by the members of the Indian community. Two more homes were built in India.
- Established scholarship funds at University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA)
- Raised money for flood relief efforts in San Antonio, during the "Great Flood of '98".
- Actively involved in fund raising for Gujarat earthquake victims. Raised over \$36,000 so far.
- Raised over \$8,000 for American Red Cross and New York Fire Fighters Association for the families of NY-DC-PENN victims
- Raised close to \$17,000 for Susan Komen Breast Cancer Foundation in 2003, with a team size of over 760 participants. This was the largest non-corporate team ever in the history of Susan Komen Foundation anywhere in the country.
- The India Association of San Antonio, initiated the partnership with The City of San Antonio hosted a celebration of the Indian Festival of Lights, or Diwali, in commemoration of San Antonio's newest Sister City Relationship with Chennai, India in 2009 and 2010. A delegation of medical doctors from the Association of Physicians of India-Chennai Chapter visited San Antonio and signed an MOU with the Bexar County Medial Society in November 2008. A delegation from the state government of Tamil Nadu visited the San Antonio River Authority. The future is bright for the San Antonio-Chennai Sister City relationship.
- The Texas Indo-American Physicians Society Southwest Chapter (TIPS-SW), the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (AAPI)-Charitable Foundation (www.aapicf.org), and the India Association of San Antonio (IASA) in conjunction with the local ethnic associations have planned a benefit program; The proceeds will benefit the Charitable Foundation of AAPI which runs seventeen free clinics in India & five free clinics in USA; and the Fallen Heroes Fund. www.fallenheroesfund.org.
- Hosted a Bone Marrow drive for the victims of Leukemia.
- Donated generously to the welfare of the differently-abled children of Vegesna Foundation in Hyderabad, India in 2009.
